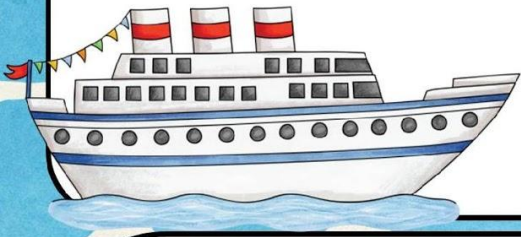


5th Grade News
